# **Ukrainian Independence Day**





This year on August 24, 2023, Ukraine celebrates its 32nd Independence Day!

- 1. The decision to announce Ukraine's independence was **made by** citizens during an event called the "All-Ukrainian referendum". In all 27 regions of Ukraine, people said "YES!".
- 2. The Independence Day of Ukraine was celebrated for the first time on July 16, 1991. The date was later moved to August 24.

<u>Ukraine</u> is a very old country. Ukraine began a long time ago when the state of Kievan Rus' started, which became the biggest and strongest state in Europe.






<u>Kyiv</u> was the historical capital of Kievan Rus' and is the capital of modern Ukraine.


## **Ukrainian Traditional Food**

These are common meals in traditional Ukrainian families and restaurants.


