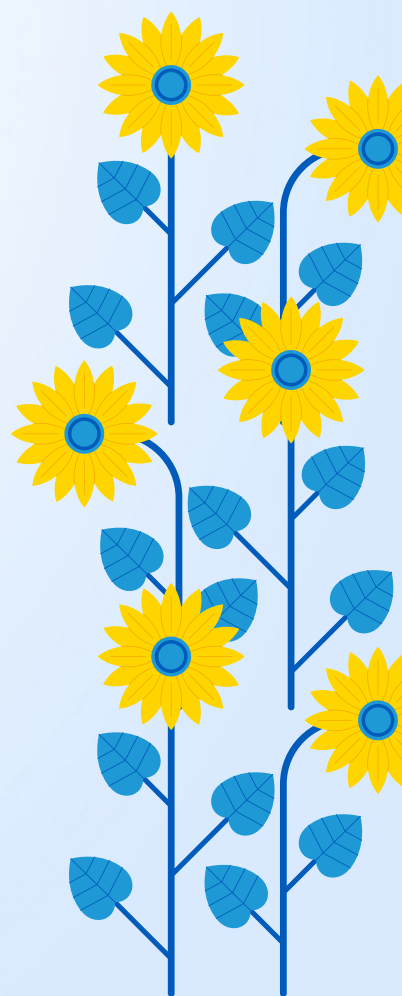

Ukrainian Independence Day



This year on August 24, 2023,
Ukraine celebrates its 32nd Independence Day!

Clever Hedgehog has some interesting facts
about this day for you!

1. The decision to announce Ukraine's independence was **made by citizens** during an event called the "All-Ukrainian referendum". People were asked only one question: "Do you confirm the Act of Proclamation of Independence of Ukraine?". In all 27 regions of Ukraine, **people said "YES!"**.



2. The Independence Day of Ukraine was celebrated for **the first time** on **July 16, 1991**. The date was later **moved to August 24**.



3. A **draft** of the Act on the Declaration of Independence of Ukraine **was written in a regular school notebook**.

4. The text of the Act consisted of **93 words**, was typed on a typewriter, and fit on **one** piece of paper.

5. **Poland** became the **first** country to recognize the independence of Ukraine.



6. On the cover of the Act of Independence it was said, "**Glory to Ukraine**", "**Ukraine has not died and will not die**", "**From today - let's be**".

This holiday is the day in which the **Past** and the **Future of Ukraine** meet **together** each year. The **past** should inspire **wisdom**. The **future** should teach us **responsibility** for making decisions.

Ukraine is a very old country. Ukraine began a long time ago when the state of Kievan Rus' started, which became the biggest and strongest state in Europe.

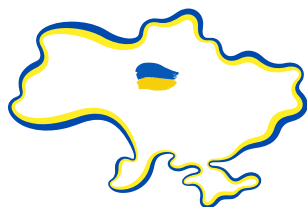
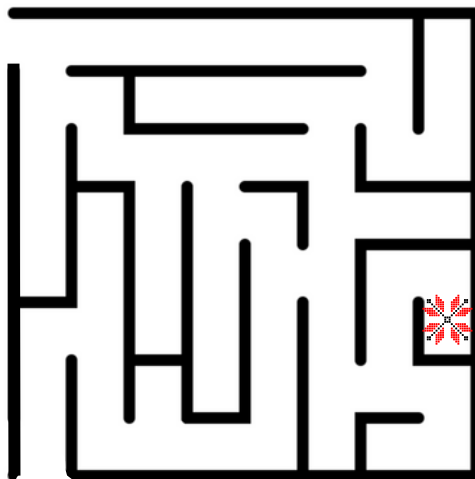


Kyiv was the historical capital of Kievan Rus' and is the capital of modern Ukraine.

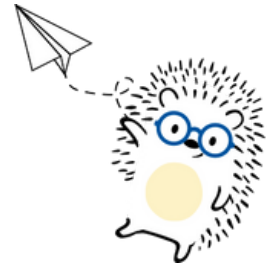

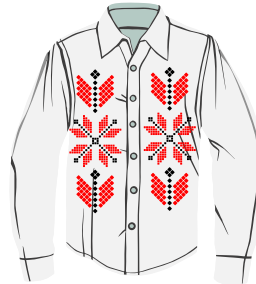

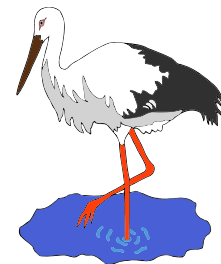

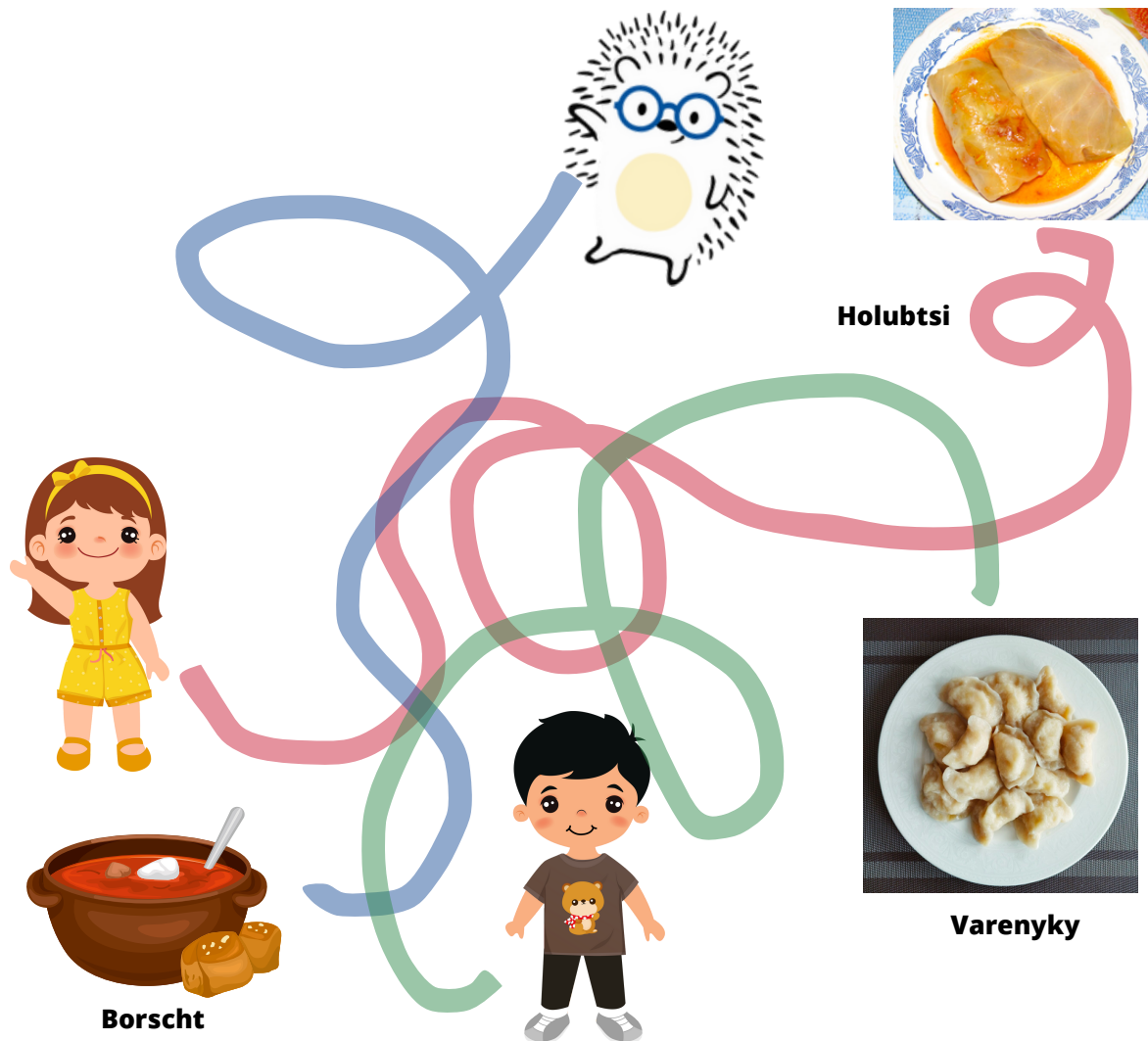
Ukrainian Traditional Food

Other favorite foods are **varenyky** (boiled dumplings similar to pierogies) and **holubtsi** (a type of cabbage roll).

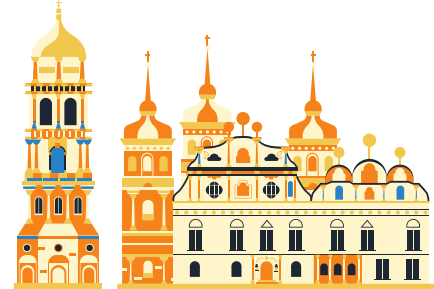
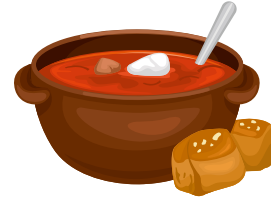
These are common meals in traditional Ukrainian families and restaurants.

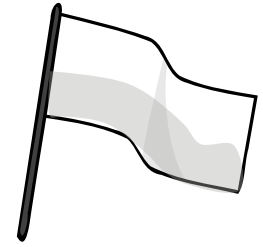
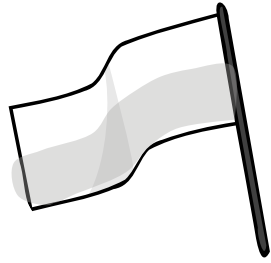
