



The Hedgehog's sister hid, and the Hedgehog went to the race and said, "If you're ready, let's start. You can even start ahead and see how I'll overtake you."

The Hare dashed off at full speed. He was running and muttering to himself, "How could he win against me? Never!"



"Hedgehog! Why would you even compete? Everyone knows that I am the fastest! What could you possibly do?" Maybe compete for the title of slowest in the forest?"




He runs to the finish line and sees... Guess who's there?


And the Hedgehog is already there (or the Hedgehog's sister)!


