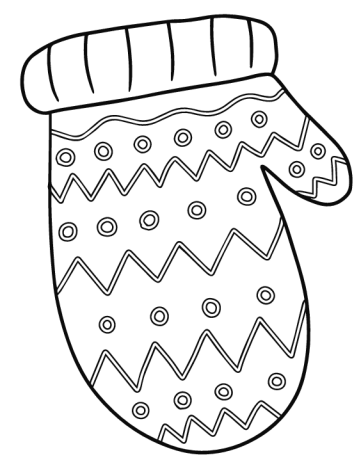


Before long, a Fox came trotting up.
