

## Halloween themed garland

Page 1


1. Print and color, if you like, the triangular parts of the garland on pages 1 and 2.



- 2. Cut out all parts of the garland.
- 3. Bend the rectangular part in half along the dotted line.
- 4. Measure how long you want your garland to be. Add a little extra length for ties or fasteners. Measure and cut the appropriate length of thread, ribbon, or string to hold the garland together.
- 5. Add glue or tape where marked. Thread the thread through. Glue.
- 6. Wait for it to dry.
- 7. After drying, the garland is ready. Decorate the room!




**Note:** For the garland, you will need a thread, ribbon, or string, the length of which is equal to the required length of the garland. The number of parts for the garland in this project is good for a thread length around 1 yard (1 meter).
